Fingering (DK)

Wingspan: 55 (61)"/137.5 (152.5) cm

Depth: 16 (19)"/40 (47.5) cm

Measurements taken after blocking.

YARN

Fingering weight

C1: 400 yd/366 m or 5 x 80 yd/74 m mini-skeins worked as a single 100 g skein, these will be referred to as

C1A - C1E.

C2: 85 yd/78 m

DK Weight

C1: 492 yd/450 m

C2: 104 yd/95 m

Samples shown in:

Hodgepodge Skeins, 4 ply (fingering weight, 75% merino, 25% nylon, 437 yd/400 m per 100g) *Coral Sol Shawl Set*.

Outlaw Yarn, Rebel Light (fingering weight, 80% Merino, 20% NZ Halfbred, 211 yd/192 m per 50 g),

C1: *Cyclops Fish*

Spincycle Yarns, Dyed in the Wool, (sport weight, 100% superwash American wool, 200 yd/183 m per 50 g), C2: *Verba Volant*

Prosper Yarn, Prosper DK, (DK weight, 100% Merino, 246 yd/225 m per 100 g), C1: *Ent*

The Wandering Flock, Merino DK, (DK weight, 100% extra fine superwash Merino wool, 230 yd/210 m per 100 g), C2: *Neon Coral*

NEEDLES

US 5 (7)/3.75 (4.5) mm

Or size required to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

2 markers, tapestry needle

When designing this piece, I imagined sitting by a fire, perhaps a summer campfire in the Northern Hemisphere or a cosy hearth during the Southern Hemisphere winter, with an engaging knitting project to savor. The resulting shawl is versatile for any season, whether worn around the shoulders or as a kerchief on your next adventure.

COLOUR NOTES

For the most effective result choose a strongly contrasting C1 and C2.

A colour change yarn may be used for either C1 or C2.

A 5 x 20 g fingering weight mini-skein set, ideally in a fade arrangement, would also work well as a C1 option for the fingering weight version, with a highly contrasting 6th mini-skein for C2.

GAUGE

22 (19) sts and 36 (28) rows = 4"/10 cm in Garter st, blocked

Gauge is not crucial for this project, but variations will affect yardage and final measurements.
